Other questions used in asking about travel information:

➤ **How do you get to (place)?**

Possible answers: by bus, by car, by plane, on foot

A: How do you get to your school?

B: I go to school *by bus*.

➤ **What is the best way to get to work if you live from (address) and you work in (location of your workplace)?**

A: What is the best way to get to work if you live from Maine Street and your school is at the center of the city?

B: By train. It takes me just 5 minutes from home to school.

➤ **Which airline has the cheapest flight to (destination)?**

A: Which airline has the cheapest flight to Hong Kong from Japan?

B: Bangkok Air has the cheapest flight.
