What do we use to store papers in order?	We use files to store papers in order.
What's a PDF file?	A PDF file's a file which <i>looks the same on any computer</i> .
Why must every file in the same folder on a computer disc have a different name?	Every file in the same folder on a computer disc must have a different name because <i>otherwise you will not be able to save it</i> .
How can you protect personal files on a computer disc from accessing by other people?	You can protect personal files on a computer disc from accessing by other people by using a password .
What do you have to enter before you can use an Ebay account?	You have to enter a <i>username</i> and a valid password before you can use an Ebay bank account.
What will happen if you make three mistakes while entering the password?	If you make three mistakes while entering the password , access will be denied.
What kind of people do governments usually keep files on?	Governments usually keep files on criminals and <i>terrorists</i> .
How long's a passport valid for?	A passport's <i>usually valid</i> for 10 years.
