Do you have any money in your *bag*? Yes, I have some **money** in my *bag*.
or: No, I don't have any **money** ...

How much money do you have in your pocket? I have *20 dollars* in my pocket.

How many euros make a pound? About *one and a half euros* make a **pound**.

How many *forints* make a euro? About *two hundred and sixty forints* make a **euro**.

a son
a daughter

[ə ˈdɔ:tə]

Are you a son? Yes, I'm a **son**.
or: No, I'm not a **son**,
but I'm a **daughter**.

Are you a daughter? Yes, I'm a **daughter**.
or: No, I'm not a **daughter**,
but I'm a **son**.

Does she have a son? Yes, she has a **son**.
or: No, she doesn't have a **son**.

Does he have a daughter? Yes, he has a **daughter**.
or: No, he doesn't have a **daughter**.



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
