(Jun faces immigration officer)

Jun: Hello

Custom Officer: Where's your visa? Jun: My visa? It's in my passport.

Jun : I'll be visiting Kowloon Company for three to six days. Custom Official: Have you been to Hong Kong before?

Jun: No, this is my first time.

Custom: Do you have any friends and family here. Jun: Friends.

Custom: Well, welcome to Hong Kong Mr. Honda. Jun: Thank you.







Useful Expressions:

- Hello can I have your passport, please? Asking you to give/ hand in the passport. Response: Here it is./ Here you go.
 = You hand in the passport.
- 2. Can you tell me your address in Hong Kong? Asking where will you stay/live
 Response: I'll be staying/living at____.
 = Tell your complete address
- 3. Where's your visa? Asking about your visa. Visa is usually posted on the passport. It looks like a stamp or a piece of paper Response: It's in my passport.
- 4. What will your job be?-Asking about your purpose. You may have any of these business, study, travel. Response: I'm here for business/study/travel for ____days (tell how long)
