

Employment status of workers







The people working in your business can fall under a range of categories of employment.

Full-time employees -Most employers define full-time employees as those who regularly work 35 to 40 hours a week. These employees typically are entitled to benefits such as paid sick leave and vacation and insurance coverage.

Part-time employees-Part-time employees are any employees who work less than a full-time schedule and may receive some benefits. Temporary employees may work either a full or part-time schedule but are usually hired for a specific project or for a finite period of time and do not receive any benefits.

Casual employees -Used in place of the term "independent contractor" in the US, it refers to a person who can work as many hours as he or she likes for a company, or for multiple companies.

Probationary employees - Employees serve a six-month probationary period, which may be extended to nine months if documented performance concerns exist.

Fixed term employees- A person with a contract of employment which is due to end when a specified date is reached, a specified event does or does not happen or a specified task has been completed.
