***Use to report someone's words**
(ex. Mother said that I should go to school early tomorrow.)

Say

- *Use when ask about the language
(ex. How do you say “book” in Spanish? “**Libro.**”)
- *Greetings
(Ex. Say “Hi” to the visitors.)

Tell

- Followed immediately by a person
(ex. He told **me** his name.)
- Use in asking for directions
(ex. Could you tell me where the subway is?)
- Tell someone the time, story, joke
(ex. My father told me a very funny story.)
