



A: ¹Excuse me. Does this bus go to Tokyo?

2 Uh-huh (informal)

That's right.

3 Thanks. (informal)

Thank you very much.

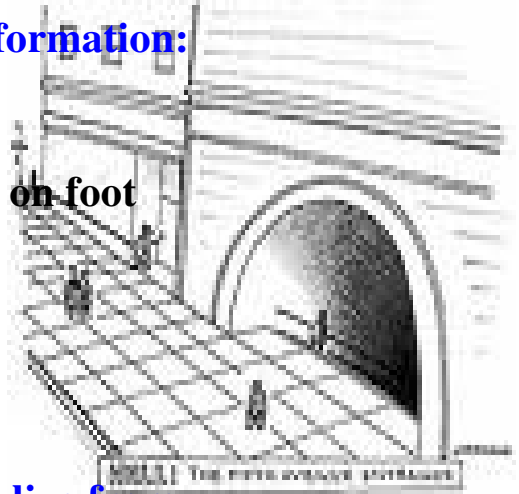
Other questions use in asking for travel information:

- How do you get to (place)?

Possible answers: by bus, by car, by plane, on foot

Ex. A: How do you get to your school?

B: I go to school *by bus*.



- *What is the best way to get to work if you live from (address) and you work in (location of your workplace)?

Ex:

A: What is the best way to get to your school if you live from Maine Street and your school is at the center of the city?

B: By train. It takes me just 5 minutes from home to school.

- *Which airline has the cheapest flight to (destination)?

Ex. A: Which airline has the cheapest flight to Hong Kong from Japan?

B: Bangkok Air has the cheapest.
